1 I Gregory P. Hansel, declare as follows:

2 1. I am a partner in the law firm of PRETI FLAHERTY. I am a member of the
3 Maine bar and am admitted pro hac vice to practice in this Court.

4 2. I submit this declaration in support of the Consumer Plaintiffs' Statement of At-
5 torneys' Fees and Costs. The facts set forth in this declaration are based on my personal
6 knowledge and on business records associated with this matter and/or my firm. If called as a wit-
7 ness, I could and would testify competently thereto.

8 **THE PRETI FLAHERTY TEAM**

9 3. Attached as **Annex 1** is PRETI FLAHERTY's firm bio, which includes infor-
10 mation about the credentials and experience of the attorneys and other personnel who staffed our
11 team for this case. During the pendency of this action, and at the request of and in coordination
12 with Co-Lead Counsel, my firm has worked on behalf of Consumer Class and Consumer Plain-
13 tiffs from case inception through settlement.¹ My firm has been involved in multiple activities
14 that were assigned to us by Co-Lead Counsel on behalf of the Consumer Class.

15 **PRETI FLAHERTY'S LEGAL FEES AND COSTS**

16 4. In accordance with instructions from Co-Lead Counsel, all PRETI FLAHERTY
17 attorneys, paralegals, and other billable personnel assigned to this matter made contemporane-
18 ous records of the time they devoted to this case, which were maintained in the ordinary course
19 of business in an electronic database administered by our firm.

20 5. Consistent with our standard practice and following instructions from Co-Lead
21 Counsel, I and other attorneys and staff working at my direction audited all of the billable time
22 entries, and deleted any entries in which descriptions were insufficiently detailed, tasks or en-
23 tries appeared duplicative, or if the specific task or amount of time billed was not reasonably
24 necessary to advance the litigation in the interest of consumers. In my professional opinion and

1 judgment, the entries appear to be reliable. In accordance with the Court's order, fee documen-
2 tation was submitted to Co-Lead Counsel on a monthly basis for their review and the final com-
3 piled fee documentation has been provided to Co-Lead Counsel for their additional audit and
4 review.

5 6. Attached as **Annex 2** is a summary of the hours contemporaneously recorded by
6 the billable PRETI FLAHERTY personnel who performed significant work in the prosecution
7 of this lawsuit. This summary identifies the total amount of time devoted to each category of
8 tasks by each billable professional using codes that are consistent with those that have been used
9 in recent class fee submissions in this Court and other federal courts within the Ninth Circuit.
10 The summary also identifies each professional's name, title, hourly rate, and a calculation of the
11 resulting fees. The hourly rates for each attorney and staff member listed are the usual and cus-
12 tomary hourly rates charged by PRETI FLAHERTY for similar work. Detailed time entries are
13 also available for inspection by the Court upon request.

14 7. I am personally familiar with the character, quality, and extent of the work per-
15 formed by each of the lawyers and other billable professionals who performed work in this case.
16 In my judgment, the work reflected on the tables attached hereto was necessary to advancing the
17 litigation in the interests of consumers, consistent with the instructions and tasks assigned by
18 Co-Lead Counsel, and performed competently and with efficiency.

19 8. Attached as **Annex 3** is a summary of the costs incurred in prosecuting this law-
20 suit on behalf of Consumer Plaintiffs. The expenses incurred are reflected on the books and rec-
21 ords of PRETI FLAHERTY. These books and records are prepared from checks and expense
22 vouchers regularly kept and maintained by the firm and accurately reflect expenses incurred.
23 Cost documentation has also been provided to Co-Lead Counsel for their additional audit and
24 review.

25 9. The compensation to PRETI FLAHERTY for the services rendered on behalf of
26 Consumer Plaintiffs is wholly contingent. Any fees and reimbursement of expenses will be lim-
27 ited to such amounts as approved by the Court.

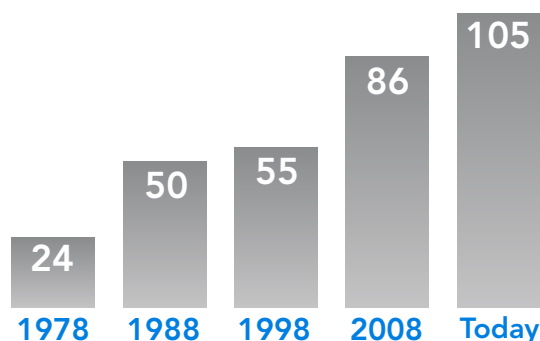

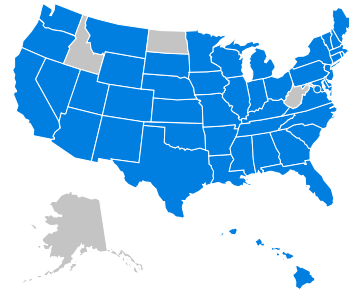

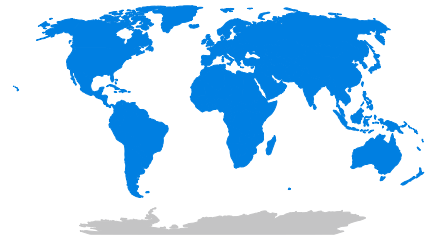
